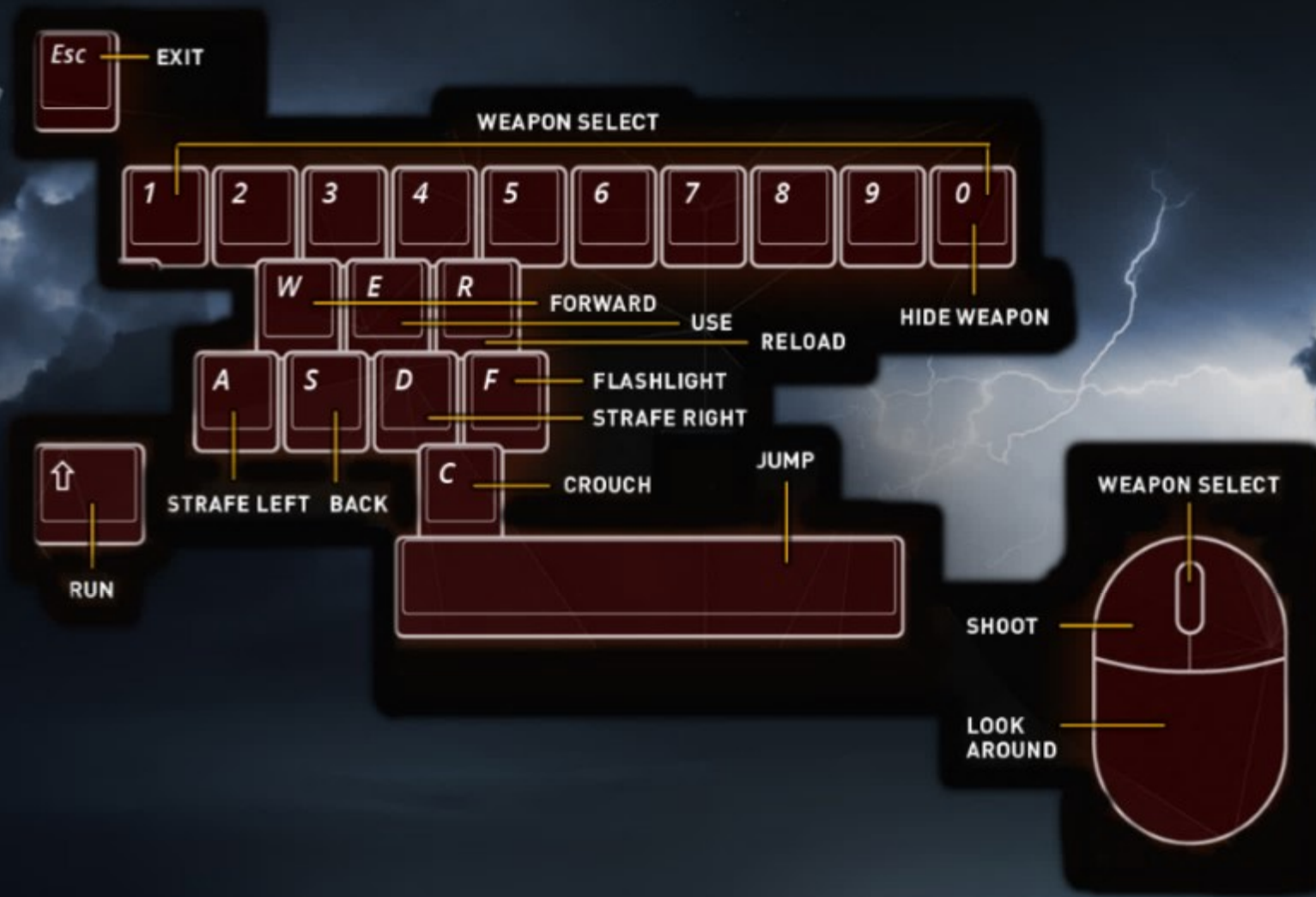


Transition between levels

When you start the actual game or complete sublevel, this loading screen appears. Depending how big the level is, this can take 1-6 minutes, so please wait so that Voltage experience can be loaded.

Controls

Some levels you will need to push/move boxes or turn on or off switches in order to proceed or find keys or items. Here are some common ones.

**Move objects (if movable): Keep down C and W buttons and move your mouse.
Decide object direction by moving your mouse.**



Controls

On some levels or sub-levels you will need to find the switches to proceed. Switches are looking like this ones. Enable or disable em by pressing E.



Game Graphics Press ESC if you need to change sound levels, save or load game or change graphics.

After starting the first mission, you can change graphics settings on the game menu . Press ESC and click 'Graphics settings'. There you can choose lowest, medium or highest and change **FOV, (if necessary)**.

FAQ:

Downloading on transitions can take 2-6 minutes. Don't press any keyboard or mouse button during the download. We assume that downloading times will become faster when Engine develops. This feature has been developed a lot during the years.

Voltage: Episode 1 includes 8 sublevels. If you get stuck to somewhere don't hesitate to ask introductions/help from Steam Community Hub !
