- **Three times a year (February, June, October)**

- **Feedback** on your demo
- **Eyeballs & wishlists** on your game
- **Marketing opportunity**

A Next Fest History

A NEXT FEST HISTORY

- **Launched as Steam Game Festival in 2019**
- **Designed to highlight upcoming games via demos**
- **Renamed to Next Fest after realizing that was a much better description 😊**

Why did we start Next Fest?

Developers were telling us

- It was hard to get attention on new upcoming games
- They weren't getting enough feedback on their demos

- Connect demos with customers who will love them
- Give every game opportunities to shine
- Help developers get feedback on their demos

Common Questions

Am I eligible for Next Fest?

Probably! The requirements:

- **Live Coming Soon page**
- **Playable demo**
- **Release date after Next Fest**

Any common gotchas I should be aware of?

- 1. Build Review for your demo is not instant!**
- 2. Release your demo a few minutes early.**

What should I do to prepare for Next Fest?

1. Check your tags
2. Check your store page
3. Check your demo
4. Have a place for people to give feedback!

How can I be more visible in Next Fest?

There is no paid placement anywhere on Steam, and that includes Next Fest.

That means you should focus on things that make your game more attractive to potential customers.

Any advice on how to make the most of Next Fest?

- Give customers a place to talk – to each other and to you
- Patch bugs!
- Learn from feedback

Can I update my build after passing build review?

YES. Please do, especially to patch bugs!

How does the Press Preview work?

- Press get a sneak peek into participants
- They can access whatever demos are already public
- An opportunity for press to draft articles early

How long should my demo be?

Depends on the kind of game you're making.

Do I need to do anything else other than join and post a demo?

Technically, no. But use this as an opportunity to talk about your game

- Online (social media, influencers, press)
- With your community (Reddit, Discord, etc.)
- On Steam (patch notes, announcements)

Am I ready for Next Fest?

Ask yourself

- **Am I happy with the current state of my game?**
- **Am I ready for feedback?**
- **Do I have a good demo that represents my game?**
- **Do I have time to join Next Fest?!**
